Message from The President

As stated in our Vision, we are committed to strive for excellence in achieving safe and quality healthcare that can benchmark with international standards, through regulating advanced nursing practice. To recognise nurses for their outstanding achievements in advanced nursing practice and remarkable contributions to nursing specialisation in Hong Kong, we conferred a record-high of 143 new fellows at the HKAN Fellowship Conferment Ceremony on 21 October 2023. In addition, a total of seven prominent leaders were elected as Honorary Fellows for both 2022 and 2023.

The Honorary Fellows include Prof. Sally Chan, Prof. Rebecca Jester, and Ms. Fiona Smith for 2022, as well as Prof. Sophia Chan, Ms. Helena Li, Dr. Carol Porter, and Dr. Wing Wa Yan for 2023. The ceremony was officiated by Professor LO Chung Mau, Secretary for Health and Dr. LEONG Che Hung, Patron of the HKAN. I would like to take this opportunity to, once again, congratulate all the fellows and express my gratitude to everyone who was involved in making this event a success. Thank you!

Following the success of our 1st International Advanced Nursing Practice Conference in 2021, several higher education institutions including the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the University of Hong Kong, the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, the Hong Kong Baptist University, the Hong Kong Metropolitan University, and Tung Wah College had supported HKAN in organizing the 2nd International Advanced Nursing Practice Conference on 25 November 2023 with the theme, “Advancing Nursing Practice: Opportunities and Challenges.” We were honored to have both local and international keynote speakers from countries including Singapore, mainland China, Canada, and the United States. These internationally renowned scholars shared their noteworthy experiences and insights on advancing nursing practice, which served as an inspiration to all participants to enhance their future professional development. There were also pre-conference workshops that focused on various interesting topics, including impact of APN roles, clinical challenges, and advanced practice nursing in Primary Health Care.

Due to the acute shortage of nurses in Hong Kong, the government had recently gazetted the Nurses Registration (Amendment) Bill 2023 to establish a new pathway for admitting qualified non-locally trained nurses with relevant criteria to practice in the region. A special registration or enrollment would attract nurses who are capable of serving in various clinical settings in Hong Kong. In line with this, the HKAN has extended its memberships to include nurses from outside Hong Kong through the revision of the Academy's Articles of Association (A&A). The two new categories, namely Non-local Ordinary Member and Non-local Fellow, aimed at fostering enhanced education and collaboration with others. Ultimately, a strong specialty nursing workforce will be built collaboratively to promote high-quality nursing services and standards in Hong Kong and beyond.

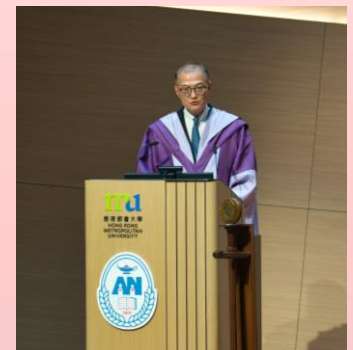
Fellowship Conferment Ceremony for 2022 - 2023

Professor Sally CHAN is a world-renowned nursing professional in the mental health nursing community at local, national, and international level. Her extensive experience in research focuses on mental health, psychosocial interventions, and family interventions. She has served on the editorial and advisory board of many renowned journals. Through her leadership roles in multiple professional organizations, she exerted significant influence on expanding nursing capacity in Southeast Asia. Prof. CHAN has rich management experience in tertiary institutions. She has been honored for her significant and sustained contribution to nursing which improved the nursing professional and the people it serves. In 2013, she has been awarded the “International Nurse Researcher Hall of Fame” by the Sigma Theta Tau International Honors Society of Nursing. In 2016, she obtained the UON Vice-Chancellor’s Award for International Engagement, and the UON Faculty of Health and Medicine International Award as a recognition of her achievement in building international relationship for the University.

Professor Rebecca JESTER qualified as a registered nurse in the United Kingdom in 1985. She was awarded her Personal Chair (Professorship) in Orthopaedic Nursing from Keele University in 2008, then awarded an Honorary Professorship in Orthopaedic Nursing Research by the University of Southern Denmark in 2017. Professor JESTER has one of the first postgraduate Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) Courses in the University of Birmingham, UK following a sabbatical to the United States to learn about ANP roles and their required academic and clinical training. Professor JESTER is an honorary Advisor to the Hong Kong College of Orthopaedic Nursing (HKCON). She supported the development and implementation of HKCON Advanced Practice Fellowships and related examination processes from 2017-2020. Her involvement included advising on the training program for candidates, developing the assessment and examination strategy, she also participated in the annual examinations as an examiner for the written case studies and oral presentation of case studies with VIVA examination.

Ms. Fiona SMITH worked in Paediatric Nursing for over 40 years. She was the Advisor and Professional Lead for Children and Young People's Nursing at the Royal College of Nursing in the United Kingdom for the past 20 years. During that period of time, Ms. SMITH contributed to and led the publication of many Royal College of Nursing standards, including that related to safe staffing levels for neonatal and children's nursing which are still used today by service inspection bodies such as the Care Quality Commission. In 2003, Ms. SMITH representing Royal College of Nursing of the UK, established the Paediatric Nursing Associations of Europe. In 2017, over 33 European countries involved and connections were also made with many other countries well beyond Europe. In recognition of her outstanding contributions and influential work, Ms. SMITH was inducted as the Honorary Fellow of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health, United Kingdom. HKCPN honored Ms. SMITH as the Honorary Adviser of HKCPN since 2012.

Dr. Carol PORTER is an expert in Focused Quality & Safety Rounding based on multiple metrics & Staff engagement. She is active in promoting Multidisciplinary Teamwork to make nursing both exciting & Challenging. Dr. Carol PORTER actively involves in nursing education and experienced international speaker on nursing leadership, staff management partnership and patient care quality. Her contribution at national level involved: being Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing, Board of Directors of the Friends of the National Institute of Nursing Research, AAN Magnet Advancement of the American Academy of Nursing and Nurse Chair of the Regional Advisory Committee of the Greater New York (5 Boroughs). Dr. PORTER is the Adjunct Professor of the Case Western University in Cleveland Ohio, USA. She also facilitated clinical visits and exchanges for nursing colleagues of Hong Kong on implementation of nurse practitioners. Dr. PORTER received 5 Star Service Award, Lenox Hill Hospital in 2003; Dean's Legacy Award, and Madeline R. Zaworski Award for Outstanding Leadership, Case Western Reserve University in 2009, Distinguished Clinical Colleague Award, New York University College of Nursing in 2013.

Dr. YAN Wing Wa is Honorary Advisor to the Hong Kong College of Critical Care Nursing since 2011. He is also Visiting Consultant at the Department of Intensive Care, Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital (PYNEH); Consultant at the Hong Kong East Cluster (HKEC) PYNEH Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy Center; Visiting Consultant at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital COVID 19 designated hospital; Past President and Advisor to the Hong Kong Society for Critical Care Medicine (HKSCCM) and Chairman of the Critical Care Medicine Foundation under HKSCCM. He works with various academic and professional bodies across Hong Kong, Macau and Mainland China on organizing critical care courses for health care professionals, including Critical Care Nephrology Courses, and ECMO Basic and Advance Stimulation Courses. He is closely involved in setting up the hospital-based Hyperbaric medicine treatment service in PYNEH, and co-chaired the Hospital Authority Task Force on the setup of Hospital-based Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy service. He had been an External Examiner for the Postgraduate Diploma in Intensive Care Nursing at the School of Professional and Continuing Education, University of Hong Kong (HKU) in 2017. He served as lecturer for the Master of Nursing Programme at the School of Nursing, HKU in 2018 and a regular speaker at the HKU Nursing Programmes.

Professor Chan Siu Chee Sophia is currently Professor in Nursing and Senior Advisor to the President's Office at the University of Hong Kong. Professor Chan was appointed by the Hong Kong Special Administration Region (HKSAR) Government to be Under Secretary for Food and Health (USFH) from 2012-2017, then Secretary for Food and Health (SFH) from 2017-2022. She has led the Food and Health (FHB) in making remarkable contribution in the formulation and implementation of various major policies on health, food and environmental hygiene, such as primary health care development as well as the fight against COVID-19 pandemic. During her tenure as SFH, she has made exemplary efforts and policy initiatives in protecting and promoting the health of the population through major policy initiatives such as embarking on a new journey in primary health care by developing District Health Centres (DHCs) in each district in Hong Kong, developing the first Chinese Medicine Hospital, opening the first Children Hospital, and developed the Hong Kong Cancer Strategy 2019, and banning E-cigarettes and Heated Tobacco Products in Hong Kong.

Before the Government appointment, Professor Chan was the Head of Department of Nursing Studies/School of Nursing of HKU from 2002 to 2011 and an Assistant Dean of the Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine of HKU from 2001 to 2012. Professor Chan is one of the leading Nurse Scientists locally and internationally and was named among the world's top 2% most cited scientists in her specialty areas by Stanford University in 2020. Her research specialises in public health, management of tobacco dependency, and prevention of second-hand smoke exposure in children. Sophia is a pioneer and founding directors of a number of signature research and training programmes in tobacco dependency therapeutic interventions, and her findings has transformed smoking cessation services and tobacco control policies. She developed various novel smoking cessation models through individual and clustered randomised controlled trials and compare ethno-cultural differences between Chinese and other smokers through epidemiological and social science methodologies. Sophia has published extensively with over 230 peer-reviewed scientific papers with more than 3,800 citations.

Professor Chan's pedagogy has been recognised by the award of Best Teacher 1996, Faculty Teaching Medal in 2005 and Outstanding Teaching Award in 2009, one of the highest honour for teaching achievements conferred by HKU. She has represented HKU and the Food and Health Bureau of the HKSAR Government in international meetings and invited by the World Health Organization to provide professional advice and leadership on their public health and tobacco control initiatives. She was awarded a Fellow of the Faculty of Public Health (through distinction) and Honorary Fellow, Royal College of Physicians of United Kingdom (FFPH (RCP)(UK)) and was the first nurse in Hong Kong being awarded the Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing (FAAN).

In light of the latest policy address by the Chief Executive of Hong Kong SAR dated 25th October 2023, the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing would like to make the following suggestions to help build a healthy and caring community in Hong Kong.

1. Healthcare Manpower Supply and Training

In addressing the escalating nursing shortage that is currently the biggest problem facing the profession and posing serious challenges to our healthcare system, we support the Government's proposal in revising the Nurses Registration Ordinance to allow non-locally trained, competent nurses to practice in Hong Kong.

Notwithstanding, gatekeeping mechanisms, such as a vetting system or other forms of certification of professional qualification and clinical experience as well as pre-service induction and training, are essential to ensure the bringing-in of well-qualified candidates for safe practices. For full registration of these non-locally trained nurses, a regulatory framework under the jurisdiction of an independent organization, such as the Nursing Council of Hong Kong is an absolute necessity for competency assessment. As the current licensing examination has a very low passing rate, a review and reform in contents and format is deemed urgently needed to meet contemporaneous nursing practice and facilitate non-locally trained nurses to come to work in Hong Kong.

2. Enhancing Public Healthcare Services

We strongly support reducing the waiting time of stable new case bookings among different specialties. In line with this, the waiting time issue has actually further highlighted the importance of developing long-term workforce planning in optimizing healthcare services. We suggest conducting a new review on the validity of data and assumptive formulae for long-term workforce planning to ensure a more reliable estimation on the required number of nursing professionals to meet the healthcare needs, especially in the areas of primary and community care and public health.

3. Promoting Mental Healthcare

Given the continuous increase in the burden of mental illness, we support those 10 enhanced measures for those with mental health needs. Optimizing mental case management requires more knowledgeable and competent specialized nurses. Therefore, training and assessment of specialized nurses are indispensable, which this issue underscores the importance of specialized nurse development. Qualified psychiatric nurses are capable of making more contributions especially in screening and early detection, follow-up of community-dwelling patients with mild emotional problems, and timely referral of patients to psychiatrists as needed.

4. Enhancing Community Mental Health

We believe that those District Health Centres and their healthcare Team members can also make significant contributions to the overall community mental health. They can help to perform mental related problems assessment and provide psychological support in community as needed. As such, we highly suggest ensuring that their nurses have undergone relevant training and must achieve the required level of competency and proficiency in the terms of mental assessment and support.

The Hong Kong Academy of Nursing and its 14 Specialty Colleges will continue to foster a strong specialty nursing workforce to enhance care quality and standards for the new policies.

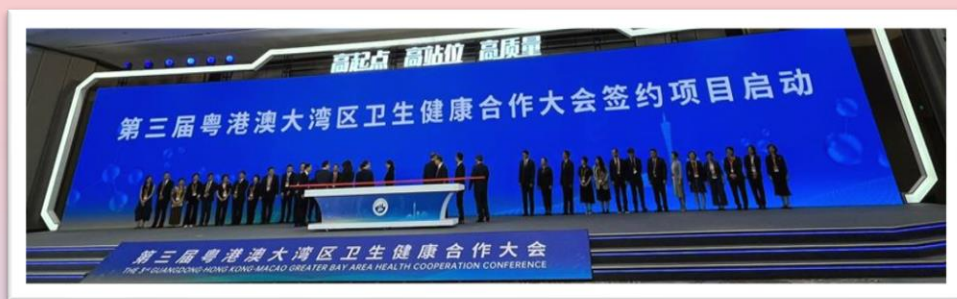
