<u>Training Funding Scheme for Registered Nurses to</u> <u>Support Primary Healthcare Development in Hong Kong</u>

The Government is committed to the development of primary healthcare in Hong Kong through enhancing district-based primary healthcare services. The District Health Centre (DHC) set up by the Food and Health Bureau (FHB) aims to promote individual involvement in managing their health and enhance collaboration among various medical and social sectors at the community level. The first DHC in Kwai Tsing has been commissioned in September 2019. The Government will proactively take forward the setting up of DHC in all 18 districts with an aim to establish six full-fledged DHCs and set up smaller interim "DHC Express" in each of the remaining 11 districts before June 2022.

Nurses, acting as care coordinators (CC) at DHCs, will focus on coordinating healthcare, social and welfare services according to the needs of the client in a holistic approach, providing counselling, enhancing health literacy and promoting individual involvement in the management of his/her own health. With a view to equipping the nursing profession with knowledge, skills and attitude on primary and community care, in particular health communication, counselling and empowerment, use of non-pharmacological intervention, as well as building up a sufficient pool of well-trained

nursing professionals to assume the role of CCs at DHCs for continued development of district-based primary healthcare, FHB has engaged the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing Limited (HKAN) and the Hong Kong College of Community and Public Health Nursing in introducing the Post-registration Certificate Course in Primary Health Care Nursing (District Health Center Module 2020) (PRCCPHCN).

The PRCCPHCN is designed taking reference to the expected scope of services of nurses working in the community providing primary, secondary to tertiary preventive care. The course in 2019-2020 has been completed with positive response. The current course will be commenced on 10 October 2020 and is now open for application. The application deadline will be on 10 September 2020. Nurses in Hong Kong who are holders of valid practising certificates issued by the Nursing Council as Registered Nurse with more than five years of post-registration clinical experience may apply for the course. Please refer to the Annex for course details. Participants who have fulfilled the course requirements and attained the Certificate may apply through HKAN to FHB for reimbursement of HK\$3,000 within 6 months after completion.
